2번입니다.

다음을 듣고, 무엇에 관한 설명인지 고르세요.

M: This is something that you ride in. It has wings and can move through the sky. People usually take this when they visit other countries.

3번입니다.

대화를 듣고, 해가 뜨는 시각을 고르세요.

W: When can we see the sunrise?

M: We have to wait 20 more minutes to see it.

W: What time is it now?

M: It's 5:30 a.m.

4번입니다.

W: Number two
